You do not have to be registered with the AKC to run in this event. AKC Official Measuring will be available. ACT Site Information: The event is given in an indoor turf ring surrounded by four-foot-high fence. Facility has heat. Crating will be in the adjacent building meeting room, heated. There is no food service at the site; there is a Wawa a half mile North of the site. Bring treats, water, crate, etc for your dogs. No backing in to parking places.

### Site location is very convenient to Garden State Parkway exit 100.

**Trial Site Rules**: 1) Dogs off leash only at the practice jump and in the ring. 2) You must pick up after your dog and deposit waste in trash cans provided. 3) 5 mph speed limit.

More about the AKC ACT: AKC now offers this pre-Novice titling event to dogs beginning in agility and is also open to a dog already competing in AKC, but without any AKC Agility titles. We can officially measure your dog to let you know the required jump height for your dog, but you may run at any AKC height in ACT.

All rounds of ACT (Standard) will run before any ACT J (Jumpers)

Q Ribbons for all qualifiers.

Additional ribbons may be offered.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I (we) agree to abide by the rules and regulations of The American Kennel Club in effect at the time of this event, and any additional rules and regulations published for this event and any decision made in accord with them and further agree to be bound by this Agreement. I (we) agree that the club or ACT Evaluator, holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club or ACT Evaluator shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the doa entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents, event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge or ACT Evaluator, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. #### INSTRUCTIONS

Dogs may be entered in any jump height. There is no Regular or Preferred distinction at AKC's ACT events.

In order to acquire the ACT1 or ACT2 title certificate and have the title added to a dog's record, the dog must be registered/listed with the American Kennel Club. **AKC Canine Partners<sup>™</sup>** applications may be accepted at the event and submitted to AKC with the event's results.

Dogs that are not AKC registered/listed may be registered at a later date and receive their ACT title at that time.

Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine Partners<sup>™</sup>** program should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

**Junior Handlers** should enter their Junior Handler Number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?

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#### More things to know about this event.

We look forward to greeting many teams attending with their first agility dog. Bayshore offers classes in all aspects of dog training.

While the dog doesn't have to be registered with AKC in order to participate, we encourage every dog to be registered with AKC. The dog would have to be registered in order for you to get certificates awarded when the dog qualifies twice in the same class. A dog may enter any and all rounds of all classes; there is no pre-requisite. ACT I and II are standard; ACT 1/2 J are Jumpers classes.

Check-in starts at 8 am. Estimated first run of ACT I, round 1 will be 9 am. Classes will be run in the order listed (ACT I, ACT II, ACT-1-J (Jumpers), ACT-II-J) There will be a short presentation for people new to agility that all should attend before we start running.

Each round will have a short briefing by the evaluator, about what's allowed and what's to be expected for each dog. Then, all are given a chance to walk the course and plan strategy.

You can run FEO and bring a toy into the ring, but no food. FEO means For Exhibition Only, you are training and not trying to earn a qualifying run. Every entrant will receive some kind of gift from the trial secretary.

An email will be sent when your entry and payment is received. You may be asked for more information if the entry looks incomplete. A Final confirmation and preliminary run order will be sent to all, a few days before the event.

#### Event and facility rules

1. Please stay home if you are sick or don't feel well. Let the secretary know if this will be the reason for your absence!

- 2. Please ask prior to touching/petting dogs that belong to other exhibitors
- 3. You can plan to work out of your car; most every parking place is within 50 yards of ring entrance or use the crating room.
- 4. Bitches in season may not compete at this event. If your girl comes in to season, please let the secretary know!
- 5. The dog can be officially measured during the course of the event; the secretary is an AKC VMO Volunteer Measuring Official.
- 6. Day of show entries may be available if the event doesn't fill with pre-entries; day of show price may be higher.

Additional rules and guidelines will be sent in final confirmation document and/or mentioned in the briefing.
